Joins Nixle

Notification System

The Seaside Police Department is participating in Nixle, a service that allows you to receive trusted, up-to-date neighborhood information for where you live, work or visit. The service is at no cost to you however, **standard text messaging rates** apply.

Here is how it works:

You choose the information you want, for the locations you want, from urgent public safety alerts to less time sensitive advisories and community information. You choose how you want to receive the information, whether it is over your cell phone by text message, by email, or over the web.

You stay connected to what is happening in the communities and the locations that are relevant to you! Registration is SIMPLE, QUICK, and SECURE. Just go to www.nixle.com and sign up to be notified when there is high water south of town or an accident is blocking streets or intersections, and even upcoming important community activities.
